

## Statement of Work Training Co-Facilitator

The Iowa Coalition Against Sexual Assault's (IowaCASA), Resource Sharing Project (RSP) seeks a consultant to support trainings from [Healing In Motion: Coalitions Supporting Growth And Change in the Lives of Adult Survivors of Child Sexual Abuse](#). The aim is to build the capacity of coalitions to work with adult survivors of child sexual abuse to better support members and their local communities.

The training sessions will address:

- Origins of the curriculum and background on holding training space dedicated to addressing the needs of adult survivors of child sexual abuse,
- Activities in module 1 (Realities of Child Sexual Abuse), module 3 (Impact of Child Sexual Abuse on the Body), and module 6 (Incorporating the Body in Healing)
- Opportunities for participants to practice facilitating module activities and receive feedback

### Scope of Work

Under this statement of work the consultant will:

- Co-facilitate selected training sessions with IowaCASA-RSP staff members;
- Collaborate on revising content and planning the six two-hour virtual training sessions;
- Debrief after each training sessions with IowaCASA-RSP staff members; and
- Compile, analyze, and document lessons learned, evaluation data, and feedback for RSP partners.

IowaCASA expects the consultant to be available for an 8 to 10 week period, which include the six two-hour training sessions. IowaCASA expects a minimum commitment of 24 working hours and is anticipated to be 32 hours. The maximum budget allocated is \$2500.

Contracts under this statement of work are contingent on the availability of funding and are subject to approval of the Office on Violence Against Women. Contractors with previous experience providing training and technical assistance to sexual assault coalitions is preferred, and IowaCASA will prioritize women- and minority-owned small business.
